11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 40.1 a section numbered 40.1-27.01 as

13	§ 40.1-27.01. Disclosure of information regarding employee or former employee.
14	A. Notwithstanding the provisions of §40.1-27, an employer acting in good faith may not be held
15	liable for disclosing information about the job performance or the reason for termination of employment
16	of an employee or former employee to a prospective employer of the employee or former employee if
17	such information [is disclosed (i) (i) is disclosed] at the written request of a prospective employer, the
18	employee, or former employee, and (ii) is documented in the official personnel file of the employee or
19	former employee.
20	B. An [employee employer] who discloses information pursuant to subsection A shall be presumed
21 22	to be acting in good faith unless it is shown by a preponderance of the evidence that the employer (i) acted with actual malice toward the employee or former employee, (ii) intentionally or recklessly
23	disclosed false information about the employee or former employee, (ii) intentionally of recklessiv
