| 16 | Juvenile Detention Commission which serves portions of the Tenth, Twenty-first, and Twenty-second |
| 17 | Judicial Districts, (iii) the Rappahannock Juvenile Detention Commission, which serves portions of the |
| 18 | Fifteenth and Sixteenth Judicial Districts, and (iv) the James River Juvenile Detention Commission |
| 19 | which serves parts of the Eleventh, Fourteenth, and Sixteenth Judicial Districts, [and] (v) the Blue |
| 20 | Ridge Juvenile Detention Commission which serves parts of the Sixteenth Judicial District [, and (vi) the |
