House Amendments in [] — February 5, 1998

A BILL to amend and reenact the second enactment of Chapter 833 of the Acts of Assembly of 1993, as amended by Chapter 642 of the Acts of Assembly of 1997, relating to powers of regional juvenile detention commissions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That the second enactment of Chapter 833 of the Acts of Assembly of 1993, as amended by Chapter 642 of the Acts of Assembly of 1997, is amended and reenacted as follows:

2. That the provisions of this act shall apply only to (i) the Middle Peninsula Juvenile Detention Commission which serves the Ninth and Fifteenth Judicial Districts, (ii) the W. W. Moore, Jr., Regional Juvenile Detention Commission which serves portions of the Tenth, Twenty-first, and Twenty-second Judicial Districts, (iii) the Rappahannock Juvenile Detention Commission, which serves portions of the Fifteenth and Sixteenth Judicial Districts, ~~and~~ (iv) the James River Juvenile Detention Commission which serves parts of the Eleventh, Fourteenth, and Sixteenth Judicial Districts, [~~and~~] (v) *the Blue Ridge Juvenile Detention Commission which serves parts of the Sixteenth Judicial District* [, and (vi) *the Highlands Juvenile Detention Commission which serves the Twenty-eighth Judicial District*].
