10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. § 1. That in accordance with and as evidence of General Assembly approval pursuant to § 10.1-109
12	of the Code of Virginia, the Department of Conservation is hereby authorized to convey to Ann Mae Q.
13	Williams, W.F. Williams and Gary Sheldon Williams, their heirs, successors, and assigns, upon such
14	terms as the Department deems proper, with the approval of the Governor and the Attorney General,
15	parcels of real property in Natural Tunnel State Park in Scott County.
16	§ 2. In consideration for such conveyance, the Department is authorized to accept certain on behalf
17	of the Commonwealth a conveyance from Ann Mae Q. Williams, W.F. Williams, and Gary Sheldon
18	Williams of certain real property adjacent to Natural Tunnel State Park.
19	§ 3. The exchange of real property shall be approximately acre for acre; however, because this
20	avaluation is undertaken in the absence of current surveys of the exchange percels of real property any

exchange is undertaken in the absence of current surveys of the exchange parcels of real property, any difference in fair market value shall be balanced with a cash payment in the amount of that difference 20 21 22 23

to the party receiving the lesser valued property.

The deeds of conveyance shall be in the form approved by the Attorney General.
