10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 9-183.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 9-183.1. Definitions.
13	As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:
14 15	"Alarm respondent" means a natural person who responds to the signal of an alarm for the purpose
15 16	of detecting an intrusion of the home, business or property of the end user. "Armed" means a private security registrant who carries or has immediate access to a firearm in the
17	performance of his duties.
18	"Armed security officer" means a security officer, as defined below, who carries or has immediate
19	access to a firearm in the performance of his duties.
20	"Armored car personnel" means persons who transport or offer to transport under armed security
2 1	from one place to another, money, negotiable instruments or other valuables in a specially equipped
$\overline{22}$	motor vehicle with a high degree of security and certainty of delivery.
23	"Board" means the Criminal Justice Services Board or any successor board or agency.
24	"Business advertising material" means telephone directories, stationery, business cards, local
25	newspaper advertising and contracts.
26	"Central station dispatcher" means a natural person who monitors burglar alarm signal devices,
27	burglar alarms or any other electrical, mechanical or electronic device used to prevent or detect burglary,
28	theft, shoplifting, pilferage or similar losses; used to prevent or detect intrusion; or used primarily to
29	summon aid for other emergencies.
30 31	"Certification" means the method of regulation indicating that qualified persons have met the
31 32	minimum requirements as private security services training schools, private security services instructors, compliance agents, unarmed security officers, electronic security employees, or electronic security
32 33	technician's assistants.
34	"Compliance agent" means a natural person who owns or is employed by a licensed private security
35	services business to ensure the compliance of the private security services business with this title.
36	"Courier" means any armed person who transports or offers to transport from one place to another
37	documents or other papers, negotiable or nonnegotiable instruments, or other small items of value that
38	require expeditious services.
39	"Department" means the Department of Criminal Justice Services or any successor agency.
40	"Electronic security business" means any person who engages in the business of or undertakes to (i)
41	install, service, maintain, design or consult in the design of any electronic security equipment to an end
42	user; (ii) respond to or cause a response to electronic security equipment for an end user; or (iii) have
43	access to confidential information concerning the design, extent, status, password, contact list, or
44 45	location of an end user's electronic security equipment. "Electronic security employee" means a natural person who is employed by an electronic security
4 5 46	business in any capacity which may give him access to information concerning the design, extent, status,
47	password, contact list, or location of an end user's electronic security equipment.
48	"Electronic security equipment" means electronic or mechanical alarm signaling devices including
49	burglar alarms or holdup alarms or cameras used to detect intrusions, concealment or theft.
50	"Electronic security equipment" shall not include tags, labels, and other devices which use radio
51	frequency-based technology and which are attached or affixed to items offered for sale, library books,
52	and other protected articles as part of an electronic article surveillance and theft detection and deterrence
53	system.
54	"Electronic security sales representative" means a natural person who sells electronic security
55 56	equipment on behalf of an electronic security business to the end user.
56 57	"Electronic security technician" means a natural person who installs, services, maintains or repairs
57 58	electronic security equipment. "Electronic security technician's assistant" means a natural person who works as a laborer under the
50 59	supervision of the electronic security technician in the course of his normal duties, but who may not

61 "End user" means any person who purchases or leases electronic security equipment for use in that person's home or business.

63 "Firearms training verification" means the verification of successful completion of either initial or retraining requirements for handgun or shotgun training, or both.

65 "License number" means the official number issued to a private security services business licensed by66 the Department.

67 "Person" means any individual, group of individuals, firm, company, corporation, partnership,68 business, trust, association, or other legal entity.

69 "Personal protection specialist" means any natural person who engages in the duties of providing70 close protection from bodily harm to any person.

"Private investigator" means any natural person who engages in the business of, or accepts employment to make, investigations to obtain information on (i) crimes or civil wrongs; (ii) the location, disposition, or recovery of stolen property; (iii) the cause of accidents, fires, damages, or injuries to persons or to property; or (iv) evidence to be used before any court, board, officer, or investigative committee.

"Private security services business" means any person engaged in the business of providing, or who
undertakes to provide, armored car personnel, security officers, personal protection specialists, private
investigators, couriers, security canine handlers, security canine teams, alarm respondents, central station
dispatchers, electronic security employees, electronic security sales representatives or electronic security
technicians and their assistants to another person under contract, express or implied.

81 "Private security services instructor" means any natural person certified by the Department to provide
 82 mandated instruction in private security subjects for a certified private security services training school.

"Private security services registrant" means any qualified natural person who has met the
 requirements under this article to perform the duties of alarm respondent, armored car personnel, central
 station dispatcher, courier, electronic security sales representative, electronic security technician, personal
 protection specialist, private investigator, security canine handler, or armed security officer.

87 "Private security services training school" means any person certified by the Department to provide instruction in private security subjects for the training of private security services business personnel in accordance with this article.

90 "Registration" means a method of regulation whereby certain personnel employed by a private
91 security services business are required to obtain a registration from the Department pursuant to this
92 article.

93 "Security canine" means a dog that has attended, completed, and been certified as a security canine
94 by a certified security canine handler instructor in accordance with approved Department procedures and
95 certification guidelines. "Security canines" shall not mean detector dogs.

96 "Security canine handler" means any natural person who utilizes his security canine in the 97 performance of private security duties.

98 "Security canine team" means the security canine handler and his security canine performing private99 security duties.

"Security officer" means any natural person employed by a private security services business to (i)
 safeguard and protect persons and property or (ii) prevent theft, loss, or concealment of any tangible or
 intangible personal property on the premises contracted to protect.

103 "Supervisor" means any natural person who directly or indirectly supervises registered or certified
 104 private security services business personnel.

105 "Unarmed security officer" means a security officer who does not carry or have immediate access to 106 a firearm in the performance of his duties.
