11	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
12	1. That § 46.2-862 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
13	§ 46.2-862. Exceeding speed limit.
14	A person shall be guilty of reckless driving who drives a motor vehicle on the highways in the
15	Commonwealth (i) at a speed of twenty miles per hour or more in excess of the applicable maximum
16	speed limit where the applicable speed limit is thirty miles per hour or less, and if this violation occurs
17	in a residence district, the court shall impose a mandatory, minimum \$100 fine, not subject to
18	suspension, (ii) at a speed of sixty miles per hour or more where the applicable maximum speed limit is
19	thirty-five miles per hour, (iii) at a speed of twenty miles per hour or more in excess of the applicable
20	maximum speed limits where the applicable maximum speed limit is forty miles per hour or more, or
21	(iv) in excess of eighty miles per hour regardless of the applicable maximum speed limit.
