6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. § 1. Indoor air quality task force established; members; duties; report.**

8 *A. The Department of Housing and Community Development shall establish a task force to identify*  
9 *existing guidelines and standards for indoor air quality and Uniform Statewide Building Code*  
10 *requirements for heating, air conditioning, and ventilation systems for schools. The task force shall*  
11 *consist of twelve members as follows: two members of the House of Delegates and three citizens, one*  
12 *each representing the Virginia Association of School Boards, the Virginia Association of Counties, and*  
13 *the Virginia Education Association, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House; one member of the*  
14 *Senate and two citizens, one each representing the Virginia Education Association and the Virginia*  
15 *Chamber of Commerce, to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections; and one*  
16 *licensed architect or engineer actively engaged in the practice of school design and construction and*  
17 *one representative each of the Departments of Housing and Community Development, Education, and*  
18 *Health, to be appointed by the Governor.*

19 *B. The task force shall develop recommendations regarding indoor air quality in public schools and*  
20 *shall report such recommendations to the House Committees on Education and on Appropriations, and*  
21 *the Senate Committees on Education and Health and on Finance by December 1, 1999.*
