2 *An Act to provide for an advisory referendum in Page County on the future of the County's high*
3 *schools.*

5 Approved

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 1. § 1. *The officials conducting the November 2, 1999, election in Page County shall conduct an*
8 *advisory referendum on that date to poll the voters on their preference for the future of the County's*
9 *high schools.*

10 *The ballot shall contain substantially the following options and information:*

11 *"Please vote for the option that you support to address school construction needs in Page County.*

12 *Vote for only one option.*

13 *Option 1. Build a centrally located consolidated high school and convert the two existing high*
14 *schools to middle schools.*

15 *Option 2. Build two new high schools and convert the two existing high schools to middle schools.*

16 *Option 3. Retain the present system."*

17 *The ballots shall be prepared and voted, the referendum shall be conducted, and the results shall be*
18 *ascertained and certified, all as provided in Article 5 (§ 24.2-681 et seq.) of Chapter 6 of Title 24.2 of*
19 *the Code of Virginia.*

20 *The electoral board shall cause notice of the election to be published in a newspaper of general*
21 *circulation in the county at least once in the period forty-five to sixty days before the election.*

22 *The results of the referendum shall be advisory only.*
